

## 6. PROPOSED VARIATIONS 59-78: MINOR VARIATIONS, PROPOSED CITY PLAN

The purpose of this report is to recommend to the Regulatory and Consents Committee that Variations 59-78 to the Plan (attached) be notified. These variations are in regard to those matters as listed in the attached table.

### BACKGROUND

Six of the proposed variations concern changes to wording within the Parts of Volume 3 of the Plan concerning Transport and Living Zones. Variation 59 proposes an addition to the explanation and reasons for a policy contained in Volume 2 of the Plan. The balance remaining concern changes to the zoning for individual sites shown on the Planning Maps. These variations relate to the zoning of small pockets of land that have a zoning that is not compatible with the zoning of surrounding land or with the current use of the land. Rezoning of some land is proposed in response to requests by land owners. Where this was not the case, letters have been sent to land owners asking for their views on proposed changes.

### NEED FOR THE VARIATIONS AND CONCLUSION

The proposed variations are intended to clarify, update, correct and improve provisions of the Proposed City Plan. The variations are all minor in nature and it is not anticipated that they will be controversial. The attached table provides details on the purpose of each individual variation.

**Recommendation:** That the Council initiate Variations 59–78 pursuant to Clause 16A of the First Schedule of the Resource Management Act 1991.
