The purpose of this report is to seek appointment of the Community Board's representatives "on outside organisations....where the proposed appointment will be of clear benefit....to the Council"/Community Board, and various "ad hoc" committees.

Current "outside bodies" include:

- West Christchurch Citizens Advice Bureau
- Paparua Community Care Trust
- Prospect Work Trust
- Riccarton Volunteer Library
- Sir John McKenzie Children's Library
- Street Garden Competition Committee
- Keep Christchurch Beautiful Committee
- Christchurch City Council/Selwyn District Council Water Race Committee
- Waimairi Study Awards Committee
- Christchurch Neighbourhood Week
- Awatea Variation
- Riccarton Business Association

Ad Hoc Committees:

- Liquor Licensing: to provide community input into District Licensing Agency hearings; a committee of two is recommended, with "power to act".
- Reserves Hearing: to hear submissions from the community on Reserve Management Plans; recommended that all Board members be members of the hearing panel, with a quorum of three.

In respect of the Community Funding and Riccarton Bush, the following information is provided:

- Community Funding: to consider applications from community groups for grant monies, and to disperse monies received through the Hillary Commission and Council funds. **Approved** by the Board, 21 November 2001. See clause 22.
- Riccarton Bush Trust: to represent the Board on the Trust. Christchurch City Council appointments, being Mr D Buist and Councillor I Ganda are to 9 December 2003 (in accordance with the Riccarton Bush Trust Act). The three Board representatives (being Mrs A Wilkie, Mrs H Broughton, and Mr M Mora's terms expire on 15 December 2003).
