The purpose of this report is to obtain approval from the Board of one new right of way name (road and right of way name approvals are delegated to community boards). It is important that approved names will not duplicate or be similar to existing names.

HEA/2000/8429, 46 Birdwood Avenue, Taraby Holdings Limited (Heathcote Ward)

A proposed residential subdivision at 46 Birdwood Avenue will create eight new allotments, with access via a new formed right of way off Birdwood Avenue.

Three names are proposed by the applicant for the right of way.

- 1. Taraby Lane This name may be confused with the existing names Tara Street or Taramea Place.
- 2. *Piper Lane* Tennyson Street was once known as Pipers Road by Beckenham residents in the 1800's.
- 3. Reddell Lane May be confused with the existing name Revell Street.

Recommendation : Due to the possibility of confusion with existing names if Taraby or Reddell are approved, the Board approve the name **Piper Lane** for the right of way.
