14. BALFOUR TERRACE - PARKING RESTRICTIONS

The purpose of this report is to ask the Board to approve the installation of parking ticks and a no stopping restriction in Balfour Terrace.

Balfour Terrace is a no exit street that runs off Antigua Street west towards Stewart Street. At the west end is the distribution centre for a lot of the city publications. It is also the back entrance to the brewery.

The request for the formalising of some unofficial parking restriction has come from the Parking Unit who are unable to enforce the road markings that the businesses have put in place in the street.

It is a busy street, with distribution trucks coming and going all day and into the evening, and large freight trucks entering and exiting the brewery. Several cars have been damaged when they are parked within the legal tolerances but are blocking the entry and exit of large brewery trucks.

There are also two fire hydrants in the street that are close to these entrances and to eliminate any confusion, it is suggested that the no stopping restriction be lengthened to include the fire hydrant space as well.

The parking ticks will define the beginning and end of the all day parking spaces and the no stopping restriction will eliminate the danger of vehicles being damaged.

These restrictions have the support of the Parking Unit and the adjoining businesses. (A plan is attached.)

Recommendation:

- That parking ticks be placed on the north side of Balfour Terrace to define the vehicle entrances, from Antigua Street for a distance of 121.5 metres.
- That the parking of vehicles be prohibited on the north side of Balfour Terrace commencing at a point 34 metres from its intersection with Antigua Street and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 14 metres.
- 3. That the parking of vehicles be prohibited on the north side of Balfour Terrace commencing at a point 65 metres from its intersection with Antigua Street and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 12 metres.
- 4. That the parking of vehicles be prohibited on the north side of Balfour Terrace commencing at a point 87 metres from its intersection with Antigua Street and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 24 metres.
- 5. That the parking of vehicles be prohibited on the north side of Balfour Terrace commencing at a point 121.5 metres from its intersection with Antigua Street and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 5 metres.
