## 17. TAYLORS MISTAKE ROAD

The purpose of this report is to seek the Board approval for Council Officers to distribute the publicity pamphlet and carry out further consultation on the roading work to be undertaken on Taylors Mistake Road.

In 2000/01 work commenced on the reconstruction of Taylors Mistake Road. The first section from the beach carpark to the first bend was completed and in 2002/03 funding is available to work on the next stage.

The work consists of a road with a 6 metre carriageway for two lanes of traffic and a footpath on the downhill side. Where it is possible, parking bays are being constructed.

Consultation for the next section has commenced with approaches being made to some residents whose garages are on the west (hill) side of the road and may need to be removed to allow construction to take place. The section to be constructed in this coming year is from the end of the completed section and as far up to the second bend as is possible with the funding available.

The design work is starting but before progressing any further input from residents and the public is required. (A plan is attached.)
