

5. ILAM ROAD – KERB AND DISH CHANNEL RENEWAL

The purpose of this report is to request that the Board approve for construction the renewal of the dish channels on the west side of Ilam Road from No. 233 to No. 277.

The Community Board approved for distribution in March 2002 a proposed kerb and channel renewal publicity pamphlet (refer **attached** plan). One hundred and fifty two pamphlets were distributed and sixteen responses were received.

Feedback on the publicity pamphlet requested that: -

One response made no comment except to advise that they appreciated being consulted.

In response to resident's feedback it is proposed that: -

1. The footpath be constructed against the kerb.
2. Property owners to be surveyed on an individual basis with a choice of street tree to determine if they want a one between the footpath and their front boundary.
3. The no stopping restriction is extended ten metres to the south of the Chateau Drive on the west side of Ilam Road.
4. Cycle lanes are considered in the section of Ilam Road south of Memorial Avenue when cycle facilities in the area are upgraded.

There are insufficient right turners out of Ilam Road at present to justify the creation of a right turn only phase at the Memorial Avenue intersection.

There are no other outstanding matters. An amount of \$178,632 is budgeted for this project, which can now be tendered subject to the drawing up of the tender plans and documents.

Recommendation: That the renewal of the dish channel in Ilam Road (Nos 233 to 277) be approved for construction.

Deputy Chairman's Recommendation: That the foregoing recommendation be adopted.
