- Recommendation:** That the report be received and the following recommendations be adopted:
1. That Council advocate to the Hillary Commission to reconsider their policy on funding safety equipment. This equipment is part of playing sport and taking part in physical activity.
 2. That Council advocate to the Hillary Commission to reconsider their funding priorities so that sport and activity at grass roots level is able to access funding. This is not occurring with the current priorities.
 3. That Council advocate to Sport Canterbury to promote Hillary Commission Funding through the Regional Sports Organisations.
