

## 6. COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT SCHEME

The purpose of this report is to request that the Board grant an additional sum of money of \$5,500 to the Community Development Scheme for allocation by the Committee in May 2002. In March 2001 the Board granted \$10,000 from its 2001/2002 Project Fund to the Community Development Scheme. The additional \$5,500 would increase the Board 2001/2002 contribution to \$15,500.

### BOARD FUNDING TO THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT SCHEME

**2000/2001** - \$10,000 from project funds with an additional grant in May 2001 of \$5,500 from discretionary funding for the May 2001 allocation.

**2001/2002** - \$10,000 from project funds for the May 2002 allocation.

**2002/2003** - \$15,500 from project funds for the May 2003 allocation.

The Board may wish to consider allocating \$5,500 from 2001/02 discretionary fund for allocation by the Community Development Committee in May 2002. This would take the 2001/02 Board contribution to \$15,500 and bring it into line with previous funding to this Scheme.

The Board has \$8,960 remaining in the 2001/2002 discretionary fund and is awaiting the return of an additional \$2,945 from Ferrymead Heritage Park.

The Community Development Adviser has received 50 requests totalling \$96,786.

This additional grant would mean that more of these requests that meet the criteria would be able to be granted funding.

**Recommendation:** That the Board allocate \$5,500 from its discretionary fund 2001/02 to the Community Development Scheme for allocation in May 2002.

**Chairman's Recommendation:** That the recommendation be adopted.
