10. STURROCKS ROAD: PARKING RESTRICTION REQUEST

The purpose of this report is to inform the Community Board that a petition has been received from some of the residents of Sturrocks Road requesting the installation of a parking restriction in Stirling Street.

A petition (appended) has been received signed by all the residents on the south side of Sturrocks Road between the railway and Cavendish Road, requesting one of the following actions be taken:

- 1. "Banning all day parking on this side of the road.
- 2. No all day parking west of the railway line for one hundred metres.
- 3. Two hour limit parking."

The stated reason for the petition is because residents do not have a clear view to see approaching traffic (including cyclists) when exiting their driveways.

There is an industrial area on the north side of Sturrocks Road with some parking for their staff. However many of the staff park their vehicles outside the residential homes on the south side of the street. A mobile home is regularly parked legally outside number 76b.

The Area Engineer proposes that a parking survey is carried out to determine:

- The parking demand in this area.
- The number of parking spaces available in the street and factory car parks.
- The most appropriate action to reach an agreed solution.

Recommendation: That the petition be received.
