

## 16. UNIVERSITY OF CANTERBURY PARKING

As Members are aware the University has, over recent months, been considering options related to on-site parking within the University campus. In recognition of the possible impact of any strategy adopted on the adjacent community the University has co-opted two Board Members to a Working Party to assist the consideration of this matter.

In late November a preferred strategy is to be considered by the University Council, and it is relevant that the Riccarton/Wigram and Fendalton/Waimairi Community Boards are informed of any decision, and of the likely impact (if any) on the adjacent community. The opportunity should also be taken to update Members with the programme of upcoming roading works surrounding the University, and to provide an understanding of the temporary/permanent impact on street parking as a result of these works.

With a view to better informing Members of the above outcomes it has been decided to host a Seminar session, at Fendalton, at **8.00 am on Thursday 28 November**.
