

## 16. MURITAI TERRACE – DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION

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The purpose of this report is to inform the Board of the result of the consultation and seek approval to proceed with design and construction. (Refer plan attached).

### BACKGROUND

Muritai Terrace is a no exit, short street that runs south east off Major Hornbrook Road opposite the Old School reserve. It is a local road that serves approximately 20 houses.

After an on site meeting in February 2002 the Board recommended that kerb and channel be constructed on the north side of Muritai Terrace from the intersection with Major Hornbrook Road for a distance of approximately 15 metres.

### DISCUSSION

A publicity pamphlet was distributed to the community for comment. Four replies were received and were generally in favour.

Comments included that the footpath was a good idea but concerned that the threshold was narrow, the vegetation along the south bank requires removal and replacement, and one reply maintains that the footpath is not required.

The threshold is 6 metres wide which will slow traffic entering the street but is wide enough for a vehicle to enter and exit at the same time.

The vegetation request has been passed to the Maintenance Team, as this is not part of the capital works project.

### CONCLUSION

As the comments made in the replies to the publicity can be addressed, approval to proceed with the final design plans and construction is sought.
