11. OXFORD TERRACE: CONSTRUCTION ZONE

The purpose of this report is to seek the Committee's approval for the installation of a 'Construction Zone' on the south side of Oxford Terrace between Montreal Street and Durham Street South (see attachment).

Chas Luney Ltd are carrying out major building construction work at 66 Oxford Terrace. This area is currently covered by parking meters with a time limit of 60 minutes. Chas Luney Ltd have requested two parking spaces to be allocated as a 'Construction Zone' so that the site can be serviced with minimal disruption to the traffic. This is a temporary measure for approximately twelve months, at which time the parking meters with a time limit of 60 minutes will be reinstated.

Parking Operation Manager supports the installation of a 'Construction Zone' at this location.

Recommendation:

- 1. That a 'Construction Zone Authorised Vehicles Only' be installed on the south side of Oxford Terrace commencing at a point 67 metres from its intersection with Montreal Street and extending in a easterly direction for a distance of twelve metres.
- 2. That the parking meters with a time limit of 60 minutes be removed in the above area for the duration of the works and that they be reinstated at the time the Construction Zone is removed.
