14. CHRYSTAL STREET PARKING IMPROVEMENTS

The purpose of this report is to seek Board approval for the installation of a disabled parking space and eight P120 restricted parking spaces in Chrystal Street (see attached map).

A request has been received from the management of Admatha Rest Home for the above parks to be installed. This is a 32 bed rest home for persons with dementia. Currently the visitors (many of them elderly) are finding that they have to park a considerable distance away from the rest home, because Shirley Boys High Students park their vehicles in this area.

Some handicapped residents also have to be transferred from a wheelchair into a vehicle, and there is no free space available, close to the rest home. It has become a standard procedure for caregivers to park their vehicles on the apex of the corner, to do this. This is not a safe practice.

Concerns have also been relayed to the Council over the Shirley Boys High School students parking too close to the intersection. This obstructs visibility and creates a safety concern. The installation of broken yellow no stopping lines would be appropriate in this instance.

CONSULTATION

- A staff and caregivers meeting was held at Admatha Rest Home on 17 September and parking difficulties were raised as a common concern. There was unanimous agreement to the proposals listed below.
- 2. The adjacent property owners at No 78 were also in agreement with the proposed P120 restriction, being established outside their property.

Staff

Recommendation:

- That the parking of vehicles be restricted to 30 minutes at all times to the vehicles displaying a mobility card on east side of Chrystal Street commencing at a point 7.7 metres from its intersection with Averill Street and extending in a southerly direction for 5.5 metres.
- 2. That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of 120 minutes on the east side of Chrystal Street commencing at a point 13.2 metres from its intersection with Averill Street and extending in a southerly direction for 70.7 metres.
- 3. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the east side of Chrystal Street at a point 7.7 metres from its intersection with Averill Street and extending in an easterly direction around the apex of the bend to a point 15 metres from Chrystal Street.
- 4. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the west side of Chrystal Street at a point 6 metres from its intersection with Averill Street and extending in a westerly direction around the apex of the bend to a point 12 metres from Chrystal Street.

Chairpersons Recommendation:

That the officer's recommendation be adopted and that enforcement take place once the restrictions are installed.
