#### 15. COMMUNITY ADVOCATE'S UPDATE

- 15.1 For members' information attached are schedules of funds distributed in 2002/03 for the Discretionary Funds (following the allocation meeting on 20 February 2002) and the Community Response Assistance Fund.
- 15.2 For members' information a list of all Board Committees, Subcommittees and Working Parties is attached.

### 15.3 PROPOSED MEETINGS

The Board's 2002/03 objectives include an intention to hold not less than two well represented meetings with all residents' association in the community in order to create and maintain mechanisms for citizen's participation in decision-making and policy development. A meeting with Environment Canterbury is also proposed as part of developing cross-sector networks at local, regional and national level which will deliver positive outcomes for the people of Christchurch.

It is suggested that the Board schedule meetings with residents' associations and Environment Canterbury prior to the end of the year. The Board is invited to propose agenda items for these meetings. Residents' associations will also be invited to propose agenda items for their meeting with the Board.
