13. ST ASAPH STREET CONSTRUCTION ZONE

The purpose of this report is to seek the Board's approval for the installation of a 'Construction Zone' on the north side of St Asaph Street between Antigua Street and Hagley Avenue.

Hawkins Construction is carrying out major alterations at 550 Hagley Avenue which fronts onto St Asaph Street in the area of the old location for the blood bank. This area is currently covered by a parking restriction of 120 minutes. Hawkins Construction have requested one parking space to be allocated as a Construction Zone so that the site can be serviced with minimal disruption to the traffic. This is only a temporary measure until 20 December, at which stage the parking restriction of 120 minutes.

Recommendation:	1.	That a "Construction Zone Authorised Vehicles Only" be installed on the north side of St Asaph Street commencing at a point 26 metres from its intersection with Antigua Street and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 6 metres.
	2.	That the parking restriction of 120 minutes be temporarily removed in the above area for the duration of the works and that it be reinstated at the time the Construction Zone is removed.
