The purpose of this report is to inform the Board of progress to date on the Burwood/Pegasus Leisure, Parks and Waterways Plan 2002-2005.

BACKGROUND

During 2001 Leisure, Parks and Waterway studies were carried out in three community board areas: Fendalton/Waimairi, Burwood/Pegasus and Spreydon/Heathcote. The aim of these studies was to provide a comprehensive analysis of leisure, parks and waterways current provision and development needs in each area. The result has been the development of three comprehensive reports which detail a number of recommendations for the delivery of leisure, parks and waterways services at a local level over the next three years.

A working party of interested Board members was appointed to prepare a detailed implementation plan, which was presented to the Board in August 2002. This outlines the service delivery and funding priorities for Burwood/Pegasus until 2005.

An update on progress on the plan is attached.
