# 5. BULB PLANTING IN THE SPREYDON/HEATHCOTE AREA

The purpose of this report is to request funding from the Board for the planting of bulbs in the Spreydon/Heathcote area, and for a planting site to be identified.

## HISTORY

Last year the Community Board funded \$5,000 worth of bulbs for planting in Sydenham Park.

## **NEW SITE OPTIONS**

The following sites have been identified as possible planting areas:

## 1. Addington Park Corner of Jerrold Street North and Barrington Street.

2. **Princess Margaret Hospital, Cashmere Road** Valley Road area through to Cashmere playground.

## 3. Centaurus Park

Centaurus Road frontage.

The above sites were chosen for good visual access into the reserves. In addition, the areas do not tend to dry out during the summer months. A major drought could dry out the bulbs in the ground, making them no longer viable.

It is hoped that a local community group will undertake the planting in May/June 2004.

To allow the bulbs to have a good showing in their first year, it is recommended that only one site is chosen this year.
