The purpose of this report is to update the Board on the Lincoln Road/Lyttelton Street art work project.

PROGRESS REPORT

As reported to the Board's August 2003 meeting, the Project Selection Team for this project has been established. The project has progressed to the stage where registrations of interest have been called for and, from those received, three have been invited to submit concept designs for consideration. The closing date for designs is Wednesday 21 January 2004. The Project Selection Team will consider the designs at a meeting on Monday 26 January 2004. The Board will be advised of the design at its meeting on 27 January 2004 (notification of the successful design will be held in Public Excluded as the successful artist will not have been notified).

The process being followed is generally as outlined in the draft Operational Procedures for Artworks in Public Places.

The Project Selection Team comprises representatives from the Board, staff, local high school arts advisor, Addington Raceway, Manuka Cottage, Addington Neighbourhood Association, Runanga, and local artists.

The next step in the process is for the Project Selection Team to select a design, which will be referred to the Board for information.

A leaflet will be delivered to the neighbouring properties following acceptance of the final design. Information will also be provided via local newspapers and the Community Board's Newsletter. The project is expected to be completed by the end of June 2004.
