

17.4 RETAIL VARIATION CONSULTATION

The Council is preparing changes to the City Plan to improve management of the distribution of business activity citywide, especially proposed retail development. The changes would help the Council to assess the effects that proposed large-scale retail development may have on existing central city and suburban shopping centres, around which transport routes and residential housing are already planned.

The changes are known as the "Retail Variation" or Draft Variation 86 - Retail Distribution. The draft Retail Variation is open for public comment until 23 April 2004.

Following this initial consultation, the Retail Variation will be publicly notified and submissions will be received through the statutory process governed by the Resource Management Act 1991.
