7. SINCLAIR STREET - PROPOSED KERB AND CHANNEL RENEWAL

The purpose of this report is to request that the Board approve the concept plan for the renewal of the kerb and channel in Sinclair Street in New Brighton for consultation.

BACKGROUND

Sinclair Street (a local road with a traffic flow of 350 vehicles/day) is on the Capital Works Programme to have its kerb and dish channel renewed in the 2004/05 and 2005/06 financial years. The local residents have been surveyed to identify the issues they would like addressed with this work. A summary of the survey results is attached.

Sinclair Street is a quiet residential street with small to medium sized family homes and no street trees. There have been no reported crashes in the street in the last five years.

The objectives for this project are to:

- Ensure the speed environment is appropriate for a local road.
- Reduce the speed of vehicles entering Sinclair Street off Keyes Road.
- Enhance the landscape where possible.
- Develop a scheme that has the buy-in of all significant stakeholders.
- Complete the project within the allocated budget and time frame.

The amount of \$637,000 is budgeted for this project with a proposed completion date for construction in September 2005. The existing proposal meets all objectives.

It is proposed to distribute the attached concept plan to residents and property owners to gain their feedback.

Staff Recommendation:	That the proposed concept plan for the renewal of the kerb and channel in Sinclair Street be approved for consultation.
