## 8. UPDATE ON CHRISTCHURCH CLEANFILL LICENSING BYLAW

The purpose of this report is to provide an update on the Cleanfill Licensing Bylaw.

The Christchurch City Cleanfill Licensing Bylaw 2003 came into effect on 1 March 2004. Attached for the information of members is a copy of the bylaw and final report on this topic to the Christchurch City Council. It was preceded by extensive preparations with cleanfill site operators, and all site operators co-operated by distributing information leaflets provided by the Council to their customers. Monitoring systems have also been set up and will continue to operate.

This local initiative is happening against the backdrop of a new Sustainable Management Fund study on reducing construction and demolition waste – elsewhere reported in this agenda.

It is therefore appropriate for the Subcommittee to request a review of what steps member councils are taking with regard to the sorting and transport of all waste, including construction and demolition materials.
