

## 8. HERITAGE WEEK – REQUEST FOR FUNDING

The purpose of this report is to seek funding for a Carter Heritage Week event to be held on 15 to 22 October 2004.

A request for funding from Richard Greenaway, Genealogy Librarian (Canterbury Public Library) has been received. Richard is conducting a tour of the cemeteries as part of the Heritage Week programme.

Last year, Richard undertook a tour of the Papanui Anglican cemetery and produced a cemetery tour booklet for Papanui. The Board provided a grant of \$200 from it's Heritage Award fund for the production of the tour booklets.

Richard is seeking further funding of \$100.00 to produce this years booklet. The booklet for Papanui is substantial (60 pages in length); and will be sold for \$2.00 a copy which will contribute towards the cost of the binding. The booklet will acknowledge sponsors and Community Boards that have contributed towards it.

The current balance in the Heritage Award Fund is \$3,140.61.
