Some! examples! of! which! include! the! facilitation! of! partnerships! with! other! agencies! through!community!liaison!forums!and!mentoring!support!(North!West!Mentoring!Project).!!In!addition! some! existing! project! services! have! continued! to! receive! Board! support,! including! Early! Learning! Centres,! OSCAR! programmes,! CAB,! Neighbourhood! Support! and! Community! Workers! (through! salary!support).!
