SEMINAR TOPIC

1. FERRIER PARK TREE SURVEY AND REPLACEMENT PROGRAMME

In September 2004 the Board received a staff report recommending a comprehensive survey and city consultation process concerning replacement of some trees in Ferrier Park.

In May 2005 the Environment Committee undertook an on-site inspection; it was agreed that the concept plan for the replacement needed more information before it was circulated to the community.

The Board subsequently agreed to the removal of a total of 19 poplar trees and 12 miscellaneous trees in the Park. Those trees were “tagged” as part of the staged removal programme.

The start work notice referred to a detailed landscape plan and community consultation process in regard to the replacement planting programme for the park.

At today’s meeting Arborist Tony Armstrong will **table** the landscape plan for members to discuss, prior to its circulation to the community for consultation.
