PURPOSE OF REPORT

1. The purpose of this report is to present the Youth Development fund applications for funding for November in the 2007/08 year to the Shirley Papanui Community Board. The attached table also includes the recommendations for allocation made by the Community Recreation Adviser.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

2. Attached is a table summarising the 7 applications for funding via the Youth Development fund within the Shirley Papanui ward. The total cost of projects is \$10824.88 with 6824.80 of this being requested from the fund.
3. The fund has \$2,947.00 available for distribution. The Community Recreation Adviser has made recommendations totalling \$2,300.00. However, the final decision relating to funding belongs with the Board.
