PURPOSE OF REPORT

1. The purpose of this report is to present two Youth Development Fund applications for funding in the 2010/11 financial year to the Shirley/Papanui Community Board. The **attached** table also includes the recommendations for allocation made by the Community Recreation Adviser.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

2. Attached is a table summarising the applications for funding via the Youth Development Fund. The total cost of projects is \$5,046, with requests for support from the Fund being detailed below:
 - Cole Nicholas Jeffries – as much as possible
 - Samuel William Dixon – as much as possible
3. The Board has \$4,950 available for distribution for development purposes. The Community Recreation Adviser has made recommendations totalling \$250. However, the final decision relating to funding belongs with the Community Board.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

4. The Shirley/Papanui Community Board has available \$4,950 from the Youth Development Fund for allocation.

\$100 from 2010/11 Youth Development Fund to represent the South Island at the Pacific Slam Basketball Tournament held in Port Macquarie, Australia from 12 to 23 January 2011.
- (b) Samuel William Dixon:
\$150 from 2010/11 Youth Development Fund to referee at the Koru Tournament held in Australia in January 2011.
