PURPOSE OF REPORT

1. The purpose of this report is to seek approval for an application for funding from the Community Board's 2011/12 Youth Development Scheme.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- The applicant, James Patrick Keleghan is a 16 year old who lives in Riccarton and is seeking Community Board support to travel to London to represent the New Zealand Sea Cadet Corps at Her Majesty's Diamond Jubilee celebrations. This trip will take place from 28 May 2012 – 10 June 2012.
- 3. James has served with the New Zealand Sea Cadets for two years and is a regular attendee at the weekly drills sessions and sail training on the weekend. This year James was fortunate enough to be awarded the cadet of the year award as well as best sailor. James has achieved his day skipper's qualification and completed a sail charge course.
- 4. To be selected for this trip is a great honour for James as he will be representing New Zealand in one of the most historical events of the decade. This event will see the Queen reviewing up to 1000 boats from the Commonwealth in preparation for the Diamond Jubilee Pageant on the Thames River.
- 5. To raise funding for his trip, James will be contributing savings from his part time job and will also be having a garage sale. To date he has raised \$900 and would appreciate any assistance from the Community Board.
