**1. DELIBERATIONS**

The panel commenced their discussions on various options, including the following:

- (a) Buffering around residential zones
- (b) Buffering residential zones across the road from brothel areas
- (c) Buffering around schools
- (d) Buffering around pre-schools/early childhood centres
- (e) Buffering around places of worship, parks/open spaces, places where people congregate
- (f) Location specific issues including those in:
  - (i) Burnside
  - (ii) Riccarton
  - (iii) Hornby
  - (iv) Aranui/Wainoni
  - (v) Settlers Crescent/Tussock Lane.
- (g) Other issues raised in the submission process including:
  - (i) Scheduling existing premises
  - (ii) Exclusion zone around brothels
  - (iii) Brothels in multi-unit residences
  - (iv) Further regulation of the location of Small Owner Operated Businesses (SOOBs)
  - (v) Signage.
- (h) The panel was undecided about the options in Lyttelton and requested that staff provide more information at the next deliberations meeting.
- (i) The panel decided to leave its deliberations on the Central City until last due to its complexity.

**2. DELIBERATIONS CONTINUED**

The panel was unable to conclude deliberations at this meeting and consequently decided to hold an additional deliberations meeting on Friday 21 September 2012.
