


2. KERB AND CHANNEL RENEWAL PROGRAMME



The Board considered a report from the City Streets Unit outlining the intended process for the consultation phase with Community Boards in developing the future kerb and channel renewal programme.

Relevant Council resolutions on this aspect arising from the adoption of the 2003 Financial Plan and Budget were highlighted in the report.

In anticipation of the work ahead, the Board had previously authorised its Works, Traffic and Environment Committee to consider a number of community submissions made to the Annual Plan on kerb and channel related matters which now needed to be worked through as part of the review process including the development of a revised policy framework.

The Board **decided**:

1. That the representatives from Hamilton Avenue, Thornycroft Street and Bryndwr Road be invited to present submissions to a meeting of the Works, Traffic and Environment Committee.
2. That the background information on the current prioritisation process for kerb and channel renewal be considered at the Committee meeting with a view to formulating comment for feedback to the Sustainable Transport and Utilities Committee in November.
