

4. WORKS, TRAFFIC AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE - REPORT OF 12 SEPTEMBER 2002

The Board considered the Committee's report and accompanying recommendations and **decided**:

4.1 REQUESTS TO REMOVE TREES

To **receive** the Committee's following **interim** proposals:

4.1.1 Stretton Reserve

That the Chinese Necklace Poplar be removed and that local residents in the immediate vicinity be informed of this intention.

4.1.2 Lavandula Crescent

That the two eucalyptus trees only be removed and that local residents in the immediate vicinity be informed of this intention along with the likely health and safety consequence of needing to also remove one of the evergreen trees.

4.1.3 Burnside Park

That a report be obtained from an external Arboriculturalist on, firstly, the condition of oak tree number 3 and, secondly, an assessment of the amenity and health and safety aspects of oak trees 1,4 and 6.

Outcomes of the further/consultation on the three separate sites are to be reported to the Works, Traffic and Environment Committee in October for consideration with recommendations arising to be made to the next meeting of the Board on 29 October.

4.2 MEDBURY TERRACE – LANDSCAPE PLAN

That the information be received.

4.3 BISHOPDALE MALL – TREES

That the information be received.

4.4 40KM/H SCHOOL ZONE

That the Board continue to work with Westburn School to address traffic management/safety issues on the Waimairi Road section of the Ring Road.
