## 1. LONG TERM COUNCIL COMMUNITY PLANS

Rex Harrison made a presentation to the Board on the long term Council Community Plans proposed by the Local Government Bill currently before Parliament.

The Board's concerns related to:

- 1. How will localised issues be reflected in outcomes and priorities of the plan?
- 2. How will local groups and agencies contribute rather than just the generic government agencies?
- 3. Can we be involved in the consultation process with our local communities?
- 4. How meaningful is the plan on a local level?

The Board **decided** to seek clarification of the following issues:

- 1. The emphasis to be placed on local community priorities.
- 2. The integration of information on local communities throughout the whole process, rather than such information being submitted at some particular stage.
- 3. Whether local networks would be accorded the same recognition as government organisations and other sector interest groups.
