4. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

4.1 Gogglebox Productions Ltd - Canterbury's Industrialists

Graham Ritchie of Gogglebox Productions Ltd addressed the Committee on his concept of 'Canterbury's Tales'.

He considered the character of a city is defined by the people who have lived and worked there, who become part of the fabric of the city and the province, and were thus Canterbury's icons who needed to be remembered.

Mr Ritchie considered that one option to recognise Canterbury's icons was to make individual documentaries on their lifetime achievements and contribution to Christchurch. Option two was to make a series of DVD's featuring people who had contributed to Canterbury in similar ways.

The Committee **decided** that Mr Ritchies proposal be referred to the Council's Community Arts Adviser and to Our City.
