#### 1. 2004/05 GRANTS TO COMMUNITY ORGANISATIONS

#### BACKGROUND

Following the Annual Plan process in 2003 the Council resolved that the Metropolitan Funding Subcommittee be granted delegated authority to allocate grants to community organisations following the adoption of the 2004 Long Term Council Community Plan.

One hundred and twenty-two applications were received in 2004 requesting a total of \$10,850,000. The amount available for allocation was \$4,862,000.

Staff assessed whether each application aligned with the community outcomes and Council policies and the criteria of the fund.

The Metropolitan Funding Subcommittee resolved:

- 1. That the application from the Te Papanui Trust for \$220,000 be forwarded to the Annual Plan Subcommittee in February 2005 for favourable consideration for inclusion in the 2005/06 Annual Plan of \$220,000.
- That the application from the Christchurch School of Gymnastics for \$250,000 be forwarded to the Annual Plan Subcommittee in February 2005 for favourable consideration for inclusion in the 2005/06 Annual Plan.
