

16. WINCHESTER STREET – KERB AND CHANNEL RENEWAL

The Board was asked to approve for construction the renewal of the kerb and channel in Winchester Street between Merivale Lane and Andover Street.

Consultation on this project was undertaken at the end of last year and details of the responses received and the subsequent changes made to the plan were outlined in a report from the Project Consultation Leader (Brian Boddy).

In its assessment of the community feedback, the Board asked that some further evaluation be undertaken to consider the contents of the St Margaret's College "Way to Go" brochure, the possibility of seal to replace grass outside St Margaret's College and a review of street furniture needs. Details were also requested on the landscaping proposed and consideration of the option of having a meandering footpath.

The Board **resolved** that the proposed plan for the kerb and channel and associated works in Winchester Street take into account the various issues raised above and further that the final approval of the plan for construction including items (a) to (d) below, be delegated to the Board's Works, Traffic and Environment Committee.

- (a) That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited on the east side of Winchester Street commencing at its intersection with Merivale Lane and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 38 metres.
- (b) That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited on the east side of Winchester Street commencing at its intersection with Andover Street and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 16 metres.
- (c) That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited on the west side of Winchester Street commencing at its intersection with Merivale Lane and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 22 metres.
- (d) That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited on the west side of Winchester Street commencing at its intersection with Andover Street and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 25 metres.
