

16. COMMUNITY ADVOCATE'S UPDATE (Cont'd)

Further to clause 3 (Part B) of this report the Board also **resolved**:

16.3 Draft Gambling Venue Policy

To submit the following feedback on the Council's draft gambling venue policy:

1. That no additional Class 4 venues be allowed to be established in Christchurch.
2. That no permission be granted for Class 4 gaming venues or machines that have been established since 17 October 2001, and that any such sites/machines be closed/removed.
3. That an evaluation be carried out of the social impact of the historical/geographical placement of gambling machines.
4. That the gambling policies take into account that there are more gambling machines in lower socio economic areas than in higher socio economic areas and that the policies attempt to remedy this disparity as best they can.

(Note: David Cox recorded his vote against these resolutions.)

16.4 Alcohol Policy: Power to Act to Community, Policy and Finance Committee

1. To give the Community, Policy and Finance Committee power to act to make submissions on behalf of the Board on the Council's proposed alcohol policy.
2. That the membership of the Community, Policy and Finance Committee be extended to include any interested Board member for the purpose of making submissions on the proposed alcohol policy.

16.5 Water Quality and Beach Standards: Power to Act to Environment and Traffic Committee

To give the Environment and Traffic Committee power to act to make submissions on the water quality and beach standards consultation document on behalf of the Board.
