

## 2. CORRESPONDENCE

The Subcommittee received copies of the following correspondence:

- 20 January 2004 - Robert Malcolm Ltd, Ian Mathews, regarding increasing numbers of street workers.
- 11 February 2004 - NZ Prostitutes Collective, Anna Reid, raising concern on restrictions on small operators (up to four people) to work only within the proposed zone.
- 12 February 2004 - Barker and Associates, regarding impacts and restrictions on Givenchy's Massage Parlour, which would currently occur outside the proposed zone.
- 16 February 2004 - Christchurch Casino, requesting redrawing of the proposed zone to exclude the Christchurch Casino from the permitted area.
- 16 February 2004 - Yani Johanson, Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board member, concerning consultation with the Community Board, analysis of the impacts on the proposed zone on existing businesses, and street prostitution consultation.
