22. EVENTS COMMITTEE REPORT

The Board **resolved** to adopt the following recommendations:

Neighbourhood Week

- 1. That Devonshire Tea provided at Innes Courts, as a more cost-effective option.
- 2. That the Committee provide the scones for the afternoon tea to be held at Wesley Home and ask Wesley to provide the tea and coffee.
- 3. That another event be hosted at Manse Place in 2004.
- 4. That the colouring competition be continued, but with a prize for the child, not the school, and that Board members target schools and churches to raise the profile of the event.
- 5. That no more funding be provided for Neighbourhood Week walks and the money be utilised in other ways.
- 6. That a morning tea be provided for a Walk n Talk programme, to take place during Neighbourhood Week 2004.
- 7. That information kits no longer be sent to Neighbourhood Support groups.
- 8. That the launch for Neighbourhood Week take place in Northlands Mall in the last weekend of September, prior to the local government elections.
- 9. That Neighbourhood Week balloons be printed, to be given away at the launch.
- 10. That a BBQ or supper be held to acknowledge residents groups' contributions in the neighbourhood.
- 11. That the Assistant Community Adviser apply for a grant of \$6,000 from 2004/05 Project Funding to assist with Neighbourhood Week 2004.
- 12. That the Committee review whether costs for bouncy castles should be covered.

13. That the Fendalton/Waimairi and Burwood/Pegasus Community Boards be approached to ask if they wished to contribute to Children's Day 2004.
