2. REPORT OF THE ENVIRONMENT AND TRAFFIC COMMITTEE: 23 JUNE 2004

The Board considered the Committee's report and accompanying recommendations and **received** the information set out in sub clauses 9.3, 9.8 and 9.9.

The Board noted that John Freeman attended the Committee meeting.

2.1 Deputation: Tom Baker, Keep Christchurch Beautiful – Litter Counts

The Board decided:

- 1. To endorse the concept of a litter strategy for dealing with litter issues.
- 2. To acknowledge that Keep Christchurch Beautiful is fundamental to the litter strategy.
- 3. To support the monitoring of sites where litter counts are carried out.

2.2 Sumner Beach: Provision of Beach Access for People with Disabilities

The Board **decided**:

- 1. To confirm its support for the Parks and Waterways Access Policy (October 2002) and the Policy on Equity and Access for People with Disabilities (July 2001).
- 2. To await the concept plan for the area from Gollans Point to Scarborough, including planning for beach access for disabled people.
