

## 5. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

### 5.1 Sumner Boating Club

Michael Sleigh (Executive Committee Member of the Sumner Boating Club) and David Lewis (President of the Sumner Long Boarders' Club) addressed the Board regarding the Sumner Boating Club facilities redevelopment proposal.

The Board **decided**:

1. To support the redevelopment concept.
2. To request that Council staff pursue discussions with the Sumner Boating Club to progress the concept.

### 5.2 Flowers Track: Parking Issues

John Vial and James Jamieson addressed the Board regarding car parking for Flowers Track residents.

The Board **decided** that opportunities for residents' parking and short term parking in the areas suggested by Mr Vial and Mr Jamieson be investigated.

### 5.3 Celia King: 40km Speed Zone Outside Linwood College

Celia King (Chairperson of the Linwood College Board of Trustees) addressed the Board regarding her concerns about the increased speed limit on Aldwins Road outside Linwood College. Ms King suggested that a 40km speed zone on Aldwins Road outside Linwood College would be appropriate as in her opinion there are safety concerns.

The Board **resolved** that Council staff be requested to investigate a 40km school speed zone on Aldwins Road outside Linwood College and give consideration to associated pedestrian/traffic issues and report back to the Board.

### 5.4 Steve Wales: Traffic Issues in Torlesse Street

Steve Wales presented a petition to the Board containing 62 signatures. The prayer of the petition read:

*We, the undersigned residents, express concern at the large number of vehicles that use Torlesse Street and other nearby streets to speed, do burnouts and drive in an unsafe and dangerous manner throughout our neighbourhood. We ask that the Council urgently investigate and implement ways to make the design of our streets safer (eg alter and enhance the circular "doughnut" designs).*

The Board **decided**:

1. To request that Council staff investigate creating a local area traffic management plan for the Torlesse Street/Avonside Drive area.
2. To request that the Community Advocate refer the contents of the petition to the police.
