

### **13. REPORT OF THE ENVIRONMENT AND TRAFFIC COMMITTEE: 23 JUNE 2004 (Cont'd)**

Further to clause 2 (Part B) of this report the Board also **resolved**:

#### **13.1 Ensors Road Reserve: Seating and Enhancements**

1. That the seating and enhancements proposed for the Ensors Road Reserve be approved.
2. That staff be requested to investigate the inclusion of colourful annuals in the planting scheme.

#### **13.2 Madras Street: Residents' Parking**

To approve the parking restrictions set out in clauses 1-5 of the Traffic Engineer's report.

#### **13.3 Main Road: P10 Parking Restriction**

That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of 10 minutes (at any time) on the north eastern side of Main Road commencing at a point six metres from its intersection with Beachville Road and extending in a north westerly direction for a distance of 17.5 metres.

#### **13.4 Sumner Promenade: Access over the Sea Wall**

That the proposed ramp to provide access over the sea wall at Menzies Street be approved, subject to funding becoming available and satisfactory public consultation.
