5. THE GROYNES SHARED CHRISTCHURCH CITY COUNCIL/ NORTH CANTERBURY FISH AND GAME COUNCIL FACILITY INVESTIGATION

The Committee considered a report from Derek Roozen (Strategic Open Space Planner, Greenspace Unit) informing the Committee of the current status of the investigation into the proposed Christchurch City Council/North Canterbury Fish and Game facility at 'The Groynes'. The report was also considered by the Shirley/Papanui Community Board at its meeting on Wednesday, 7 July 2004, and by the Community and Leisure Committee at its meeting on Monday, 12 July 2004.

- 3. That the Council continue to work with the North Canterbury Fish and Game Council to find an appropriate locality for the facility.
