


2. LIQUOR BAN FOR ILAM AREA



The Regulatory and Consents Committee recommended in a report to the 1 July 2004 Council meeting that further consultation on alcohol related problems in the Ilam area be undertaken to determine whether a Council resolution is necessary to amend the bylaw. The Committee also recommended that a process for the amendment of the bylaw be adopted by the Council, which involved initial requests being brought before the Regulatory and Consents Committee, and then being referred to the appropriate community board before the Committee makes a recommendation to the Council regarding an amendment to the bylaw.

Following the adoption of the Committee's recommendations at the 1 July 2004 Council meeting, the Committee will give consideration at this meeting to the means by which progress on liquor related issues in the Ilam area may proceed.

Recommendation: That the Alcohol Policy Subcommittee continue to work through the issues of alcohol related disorder in Ilam with:

- The Police,
- The University,
- Local residents' associations,
- Neighbourhood Support,
- The Riccarton/Wigram Community Board and community advocate,
- Local elected members,
- Holders of liquor licences in the Ilam area,
- The District Licensing Agency, and
- Other representatives the Subcommittee considers relevant

and report back to the Regulatory and Consents Committee with its recommendations.

(Note: The above recommendation was passed unanimously by the Committee members present being Councillors Broughton, Ganda, Keast, Sheriff, Wells and Withers. It was noted that Councillors Buck and Harrow, although not part of the Committee, also expressed support for the recommendation.)
