

9. NEW BUS STOP LOCATIONS

The Board's approval was sought for the establishment of ten permanent bus stops, as a result of the Environment Canterbury North-west and Southern bus service reviews, and no stopping restrictions to facilitate a turning area for buses.

The Board **resolved**:

1. To approve the installation of bus stops in the locations described in (a) to (e) inclusive and (g) and (i) of the officer's report.
2. That, owing to the number of residents seeking speaking rights regarding the proposed location of bus stops and extended route on Dyers Pass Road and Bowenvale Avenue, the Board establish a hearings panel (comprising Phil Clearwater as Chairman, Barry Corbett and Paul de Spa) to meet on Wednesday, 28 July 2004 at 4.30pm, to hear residents' concerns.
3. That the following matters be referred to the hearings panel:
 - (a) Recommendation (f) of the officer's report.
 - (b) Recommendation (j) of the officer's report.
 - (c) Recommendation (k) of the officer's report.
 - (d) Recommendation (l) of the officer's report.
 - (e) The petition received from Brian Meadows (Dyers Pass Road).
4. That the proposed installation of a bus stop on the south-east side of Rose Street commencing at a point 31 metres from its intersection with Cashmere View Street and extending in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 12 metres (94 Rose Street) be deferred, pending consultation with Cashmere View Hospital regarding the current stop remaining in place (recommendation (h) of the officer's report).
5. That the hearings panel report back to the Board with recommendations.
