## 9. NEW BUS STOP LOCATIONS

The Board's approval was sought for the establishment of ten permanent bus stops, as a result of the Environment Canterbury North-west and Southern bus service reviews, and no stopping restrictions to facilitate a turning area for buses.

## The Board **resolved**:

- 1. To approve the installation of bus stops in the locations described in (a) to (e) inclusive and (g) and (i) of the officer's report.
- 2. That, owing to the number of residents seeking speaking rights regarding the proposed location of bus stops and extended route on Dyers Pass Road and Bowenvale Avenue, the Board establish a hearings panel (comprising Phil Clearwater as Chairman, Barry Corbett and Paul de Spa) to meet on Wednesday, 28 July 2004 at 4.30pm, to hear residents' concerns.
- 3. That the following matters be referred to the hearings panel:
  - (a) Recommendation (f) of the officer's report.
  - (b) Recommendation (j) of the officer's report.
  - (c) Recommendation (k) of the officer's report.
  - (d) Recommendation (I) of the officer's report.
  - (e) The petition received from Brian Meadows (Dyers Pass Road).
- 4. That the proposed installation of a bus stop on the south-east side of Rose Street commencing at a point 31 metres from its intersection with Cashmere View Street and extending in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 12 metres (94 Rose Street) be deferred, pending consultation with Cashmere View Hospital regarding the current stop remaining in place (recommendation (h) of the officer's report).
- 5. That the hearings panel report back to the Board with recommendations.
