

2. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

2.1 ANDY WYLLIE - PROGRAMME TO COMPLETE THE WASHINGTON RESERVE SKATE PARK

Mr Andy Wyllie requested that the Council expedite Stage 3 of the Washington Reserve skate facility set down for completion during the 2007/08 financial year. He also recommended that the Council acknowledge the expertise and experience available from the United States of America, and to seek such advice in upgrading the Washington Reserve facility to a recreational but challenging skate park.
