



8. RESEALING OF VEHICLE ENTRANCEWAYS

The Committee considered a report from Ken Stevenson, Asset Management Team Leader, City Transport Unit advising the Committee of the request from the Fendalton/Waimairi and Riccarton/Wigram Community Boards that the Committee review the current policy/practice on the maintenance of vehicle entrances.

The report advised the Committee of the recommendations passed at recent meetings of the two Community Boards and the receipt of a petition from residents in Harkness Place to the Fendalton/Waimairi Community Board in November 2003.

The report noted that this policy had been considered by the Council in May 2001 and attached a copy of the report considered by the Committee at that time. In addition it updated the costs that had been included in that report in respect to the additional budget provision be required for implementing the change in the policy to reseal all vehicle entranceways and noted that these were now estimated at \$285,000 per annum for resurfacing and \$55,000 for maintenance.

The Committee **decided** to review the current policy on the maintenance of vehicle entrances and requested that a report on the issues, options and additional costs be presented to the Committee by July 2004.
