13. NOTICES OF MOTION

RATE INCREASES

Councillor Broughton has given notice pursuant to Standing Order 2.16 that she proposes to move the following motion:

- "1. That for this coming year (2005/06) the Council only accept a rate increase of between 2.0% and 2.7%, being in line with the current rate of inflation.
- 2. That future rate increase projections in the Long Term Council Community Plan be in line with the predicted general rate of inflation or less.
- 3. That management table options to bring this year's rate increase in line with the above."

RE-ESTABLISHMENT OF JOINT COMMITTEE WITH ENVIRONMENT CANTERBURY
