## **PURPOSE OF REPORT**

1. The purpose of this report is to obtain approval to legalise a link strip of land as road pursuant to Section 114 Public Works Act 1981.

# **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

- 2. The subdivision consent at Northwood Boulevard, dated 3 October 2001, under the heading future road connection, provided for Lot 5001 DP 309673 containing 4m² to be constructed as road and to be transferred to the Christchurch City Council free of charge. The Council also undertook not to dedicate the link strip as road until a period of five years from the date of the consent had elapsed or a shorter period with the agreement of the consent holder, Northwood Views Ltd. Approved barriers were subsequently installed on the link strip and maintained by the Council.
- 3. With the physical barriers having been removed some time ago and the land formed as road, Northwood Views Ltd are happy for the road legalisation to be completed.

# FINANCIAL AND LEGAL CONSIDERATIONS

All costs associated with this legalisation (and these are minor) will be met by the Council.

## STAFF RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Council approve the legalisation of Lot 5001 DP 309673 as road pursuant to Section 114 of the Public Works Act 1981.
