

NOTICES OF MOTION

1. NOTICE OF MOTION TO RESCIND PREVIOUS COUNCIL RESOLUTION REGARDING CATHEDRAL SQUARE LIGHT VEHICLE BAN

To consider the following motion, notice of which has been given pursuant to Standing Order 2.18.14:

1. Pursuant to Standing Order 2.18.14, we hereby give notice of an intention to move a motion at the 19 May 2005 Council meeting to revoke the following resolution adopted by the Council at its meeting on Thursday 11 November 2004 regarding clause 9 of the agenda "Cathedral Square Light Vehicle Ban":

- "1. That the Council acknowledge that there is a problem with vehicle noise across Christchurch.*
- 2. That the Council facilitate a discussion with relevant stakeholders to canvass solutions to the problem.*
- 3. That, as a matter of urgency representations be made to Local Government New Zealand, Land Transport New Zealand and other government agencies with regard to excessive vehicle noise.*
- 4. That the attention of the Police be drawn to the petition of 27 May 2004 which clearly outlines the problem of noise in Cathedral Square and that the Council encourage the Police to enforce the relevant legislation regulating noise from vehicles."*

2. We also intend at the same meeting to move the following motion in substitution therefor:

- "1. That a bylaw is the most appropriate means of addressing the problem of noise from cars late at night in Cathedral Square and its approaches.*
- 2. That the most appropriate form of bylaw for this purpose is the Christchurch City Traffic and Parking Bylaw 1991 amended in the manner detailed in clause 4 below.*
- 3. That such amendments to the Christchurch City Traffic and Parking Bylaw 1991 do not give rise to any implications under the New Zealand Bill of Rights Act 1990.*
- 4. That the Christchurch City Traffic and Parking Bylaw 1991 be amended by:*
 - (a) Inserting a paragraph (e) of clause 68A(2) the following paragraph:
'(f) Any commercial passenger vehicle'*
 - (b) Revoking the Ninth Schedule of the above bylaw and substituting the schedule which is contained in the attachment marked 'Appendix 1'.*
- 5. That the abovementioned amendments come into effect on 1 July 2005."*

The Notice of Motion has been signed by Councillors Bob Shearing, Sally Buck, Graham Condon, Helen Broughton and Carole Evans. It therefore complies with the requirements of Standing Order 2.18.14 relating to the revocation or alteration of resolutions, in that it is signed by not less than one third of the members of the Council.
