**REPORT BY THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE  
SPREYDON/HEATHCOTE COMMUNITY BOARD**

**PART A - MATTERS REQUIRING A COUNCIL DECISION**

**1. MOORHOUSE AVENUE TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT & SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS  
(HAGLEY AVENUE TO BARBADOES STREET)**

At its meeting on Tuesday 21 March 2006 the Spreydon/Heathcote Community Board considered a report by the General Manager City Environment, which sought approval for:

- (a) The Moorhouse Avenue Traffic Management and Safety Improvements project to proceed to implementation.
- (b) New traffic restrictions associated with the project.

The project affects both the Spreydon/Heathcote and Hagley/Ferrymead communities. Full details of the project and the associated traffic restrictions proposed are set out in a separate report by the Chairperson of the Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board to the present Council meeting.

The Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board has recommended approval of the staff recommendations, with one exception. However, the Spreydon/Heathcote Community Board recommends adoption of the staff recommendations in toto.

**BOARD RECOMMENDATION**

That the staff recommendations as set out in the report by the Chairperson of the Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board be adopted.
